

D) Rock Climbing Special: All of Survival Island PLUS... Top Roping with harnesses and belaying up to 20 feet available. This includes bouldering. (60 mins.) Just \$8.99/child. Bare Foot Required. Ages: 5 to 14 yrs.

*All SI / Rock Climbing activities are maximum 25 kids at one time, however, if combined with other activities larger groups can be split between two or more activities to allow up to 50 or more to do Rock Climbing.

Groups scheduling more than one activity may be divided at KGC discretion. All activities are supervised and under the direction of KGC Faculty. All groups are required to send one counselor/chaperone per every 6 children. Please read carefully the chaperone rules on the back.

No outside food unless previously arranged. Tables are <u>sometimes</u> available if your group would like to stay for 30 mins. <u>after</u> your visit to have a snack. <u>This arrangement must be made ahead of time in writing and signed by our Groups Manager.</u> Although there is no charge when the seating is available, clean up of tables, chairs, and floor after eating is your responsibility. We can help you arrange pizza delivery at a discount price, if you call a week ahead of time.


No injured or sick children please. No stitches, arm or leg braces or casts. 10 child minimum. No wire rim glasses in gym or rock area. Shorts or sweat pants are best. Nonrefundable deposit w/in 48 hours of booking: 10-19 kids \$45/activity deposit. 20 or more kids \$90/activity deposit.

Weekend Group Visits are scheduled and priced as "Parties" and should be booked through our Party Manager, not the Groups Manager. All group visits are by special arrangement and require setting up special faculty schedules so your patience is appreciated. It is best to book at least 6 weeks ahead but <u>sometimes</u> we can help you even at the last minute, if you get rained out of something else. The Leader in charge of your group must sign a copy of this flyer and include with deposit.

*Special Needs Children are welcomed, but please remember to tell us when you are booking so we can be prepared to take good care of your needs.

Group Leader:

We want to continue to invite your group back every year. Please make sure that every chaparone understands their responsibilities by giving each of them a copy of the following.

Group Chaperone Rules

You have volunteered to chaperone your group to come visit Kehler's Gymnastics Centers. This is a very big responsibility! We provide Groups with large discounts with the understanding that the following guidelines will be strictly enforced. Please notify your group leader immediately if you are unable or unwilling to cheerfully and actively participate in any of the following activities:

1) Follow directions from KGC staff.

If you have issues with authority, please ask to be excused from this responsibility <u>now</u> so your group leader has time to find a cooperative substitute. <u>KGC staff are in charge</u> while you are in the facility.

Your visit here is for a prescribed period of time. That time includes the time required for changing shoes, explaining rules to chaperones & kids, etc. We will not extend your visit time if the adults' lack of cooperation or participation delays the beginning of activity time.

Failure to follow any directions given to you by KGC staff may result in the entire group being asked to leave w/o refund.

2) Actively assist supervision of the children. Chaperones must be on their feet, not seated on the sidelines.

3) You may be required to wear socks. Bring them with you.

4) Assist your group with their shoes or clothing & clean up table area.

5) If you wish to bring siblings, get permission from the group leader first. You may be required to pay separately for them.

6) Leave valuables, purses, food, beverages, etc. at home.
